POOL AND TENNIS RULES

THESE RULES ARE MADE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ERIE COUNTY HEALTH DEPT FOR YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY. THE LIFEGUARDS ARE HERE TO ENFORCE THEM. PLEASE RESPECT THEIR AUTHORITY.

Audubon Association Pool Rules:

Each Audubon resident is entitled to bring one (1) guest. Additional guests (adult or child) will be charged \$3.00 per day. If you bring a guest to the pool, you **must** remain at the pool with your guest throughout their visit.

In order to be eligible to use the pool, your quarterly assessment payments must be paid up-to-date.

All persons using the pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility.

1. **Children under thirteen (13)** years of age **MUST** be accompanied by an adult or guardian fifteen (15) years or older. A **baby-sitter** may not accompany more than two (2) children in addition to their own.
 2. Anyone wishing to swim in water above their shoulders **must** be able to pass a 25 yard swimming test at the discretion of the lifeguards.
 3. Members will be held responsible for all actions of their guests and children. Number of guests will be up to the discretion of supervising lifeguard.
 4. The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of bad weather, equipment malfunction, overcrowding, or at the discretion of management and/or the Certified Pool Operator or lifeguards.
 5. The Audubon Association, Inc., management or lifeguards will not be responsible for loss or damage to any personal property of any kind.
 6. The wading pool is limited to the use of children under seven (7) years of age **ONLY** and they **MUST** be accompanied by an adult fifteen (15) years or older.
 7. Running, pushing, wrestling, dunking or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool area will not be tolerated. **Children of any age that are chronic behavior problems may be restricted from using the pool.**
 8. Flotation bubbles, life preservers and water wings will be allowed in the shallow end of the pool **ONLY**. All children wearing flotation devices **MUST** be accompanied **IN THE WATER** by an adult fifteen (15) years or older.
 9. Play equipment (beach balls, plastic floats, etc.) may be used in the pool area at the lifeguards' discretion.
110818000. **NO** pets are allowed within the pool area.
110818001. Admission shall be refused to all persons having any infectious diseases, inflamed eyes, a cold, nasal or ear discharges, poison ivy or any communicable diseases of any kind. Persons with excessive sunburn or open sores will not be permitted to use the pool.
110818002. Urinating, spitting or blowing the nose in the pool is prohibited.
110818003. **State Health Law prohibits:** All but plain white T-shirts, jeans - denim shorts, disposable or cloth diapers without rubber pants and cut-off, frayed or soiled shorts.
110818004. **THIS IS A FAMILY ORIENTED POOL, APPROPRIATE SWIM WEAR IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES.**
110818048. No abusive or profane language will be tolerated.
110818049. No food or drinks except water in plastic containers will be permitted in the pool area.
110818050. **SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED** in the pool area.

110818051. Walkway areas leading to the pool must be kept free from bicycles, skateboards, and roller- blades. **BIKE RACKS MUST BE USED.**
110818052. No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards or radios are allowed within the pool area.
110818053. MANAGEMENT and LIFEGUARDS are responsible for the strict enforcement of the rules as set by the Audubon Pool Committee and Board of Health.
110818054. **SWIMMING IS NOT PERMITTED WITHOUT A LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. PERSONS FOUND USING THE POOL AFTER HOURS WILL BE CHARGED WITH TRESPASSING AND WILL LOSE THE USE OF THEIR POOL PRIVILEGES FOR THE SEASON.**

AUDUBON ASSOCIATION TENNIS RULES

COURTS ARE FOR TENNIS ONLY. NO ROLLERBLADES, SKATEBOARDS, HOCKEY GAMES AND BICYCLES ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.

Four (4) tennis courts are located near Walton Pond Center and one (1) court is located in the Walton Woods area. To prevent vandalism and abuse, access to the courts is by key only. One (1) tennis key is issued per household and must be obtained by an adult member of the household. A \$5.00 fee is charged for a key. A replacement fee of \$7.00 will be charged for any lost key. Keys may be obtained at the Audubon office.

Weather permitting; the tennis courts are available for use mid-April through September. Tennis Rules are posted at the courts. Some highlights are:

1. The courts are available for use **ONLY** by Audubon Association members and their guests.
2. **Tennis shoes or sneakers are required.**
3. **NO** food or drink is permitted within the tennis court fencing.
4. **After 5 P.M.** the courts are available for use by adults or residents 16 years of age or older. Children may play only if accompanied and playing tennis with an adult.
5. **NO** rollerblades skateboards or bicycles allowed on the courts at **any time.**

No schedule of court hours will be posted. The courts are available on a first-come basis. When others are waiting, those on the courts **must** limit their play to one set or one hour, which-ever comes first. (Doubles must be played when others are waiting.)
